EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY EXPERIENCED FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC

The East Bridgewater Fire Department is accepting applications, with resumes, for experienced Firefighter/Paramedics until the position(s) are filled. Applicants MUST be certified paramedics. Applicants who have been Pro Board-certified FF I/II with at least five (5) years' full-time experience will be given preference. The applicant must be a non-smoker and is prohibited from using tobacco and marijuana products while employed. Women, minorities, and military veterans are encouraged to apply. This position is subject to a minimum one (1) year probationary period. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled.

Benefits per the current Collective Bargaining Agreement include:

- Base salary range for Firefighter/Paramedic is \$64,422.37 \$88,757.66, max after 20 years.
- Experienced career firefighter/paramedics will start at a higher step, plus have benefits pro-rated commensurate with their years of experience.
- Six (6) weeks' vacation leave after 20 years of service.
- 14 paid holidays per year (7 paid, 7 used as time-off) and 28 hours of personal leave.
- Paid sick leave.
- Longevity pay after five (5) years of service with the Town.
- Tuition reimbursement.
- Education incentive depending on college credits/degree(s) 4% for 12 credits, 6% for 30 credits, 10% for associates degree, 12% for bachelor's degree and 15% for a master's degree added to base salary for certain degree programs per the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- Uniform allowance.
- Town pays 70% of Health Insurance premiums for HMO's, 60% for PPO's, 50% for Dental.

Applicants selected for employment and prior to beginning employment MUST pass a physical exam, including a drug test; pass a thorough background check, including CORI; Pass a MA Human Resources Physical Abilities Test (PAT). Selected applicants must submit a copy of ACLS, PALS, CPR and EMT-P certifications; a certified copy of certificate of birth: a copy of high school diploma or GED; a copy of a valid driver's license and a ten (10) year driving record.

Applicants selected for employment will be subject to the following within one (1) year of employment:

- Successful completion of the Massachusetts Firefighting Academy Career Recruit Program and must be Pro Board certified to the level of Firefighter I/II (subject to Academy availability). Preference will be given to applicants who are already certified FF I/II and do not need to attend the academy.
- Residency per the current Collective Bargaining Agreement which is 20 miles from East Bridgewater, within one (1) year of employment.
